A must on your Canada tour, this 12minute adventure follows the spine of the grand Goat Range, sweeping over Spray Valley right up to the famous Three Peaks, a trio of volcanic mountains that each top 10,000 ft. A pure magnet for adventurers, tourists and locals, a helicopter tour of these three peaks often counts among the best Canada tourism experiences.

The sights do not fade once you circle this iconic landmark; your return flight presents you with exquisite views of the gurgling Bow River as it makes its way back towards the town of Canmore.
