

Traveling along Kluane Lake's scenic shore, today's tour includes a visit to Sheep Mountain Visitor Center, offering a chance to spot Dall sheep in their natural habitat. The journey continues to Soldier Summit, where travelers learn about the Alaska Highway's historic construction. By afternoon, the day's exploration concludes at the iconic Alaska-Canada border.

Day 4: From Wrangell Peaks to Valdez's Snowy Shores

Beginning on the Glenn Highway, the tour takes guests past Wrangell-St. Elias National Park, continuing south on the Richardson Highway to the coastal town of Valdez. Surrounded by majestic snow-covered mountains, Valdez, or "Little Switzerland," marks the end of the Trans Alaska Pipeline. This stunning town offers an unforgettable mix of natural grandeur and industrial history.

- Ferry across stunning Prince William Sound
- Marvel at fjords and glaciers along the Pacific Coast

Today, guests embark on a ferry ride across Prince William Sound, with stunning fjord and glacier views that are truly Alaskan highlights. Wildlife sightings may delight with otters, sea lions, and whales. Once ashore, the journey



continues through the Chugach Mountains to Seward, where travelers can savour Alaskan king crab and take a peaceful walk along the coast.
