

Day 1: Welcome to Whitehorse: Start Your Arctic Adventure

You'll also be welcomed by an Inuvialuit family to experience traditional delicacies like muktuk and mipku. Discover the wonders of the Arctic and the rich culture of its people.

- Visit Inuvik's iconic Igloo Church before departure.
- Fly back to Whitehorse for a free afternoon.
